

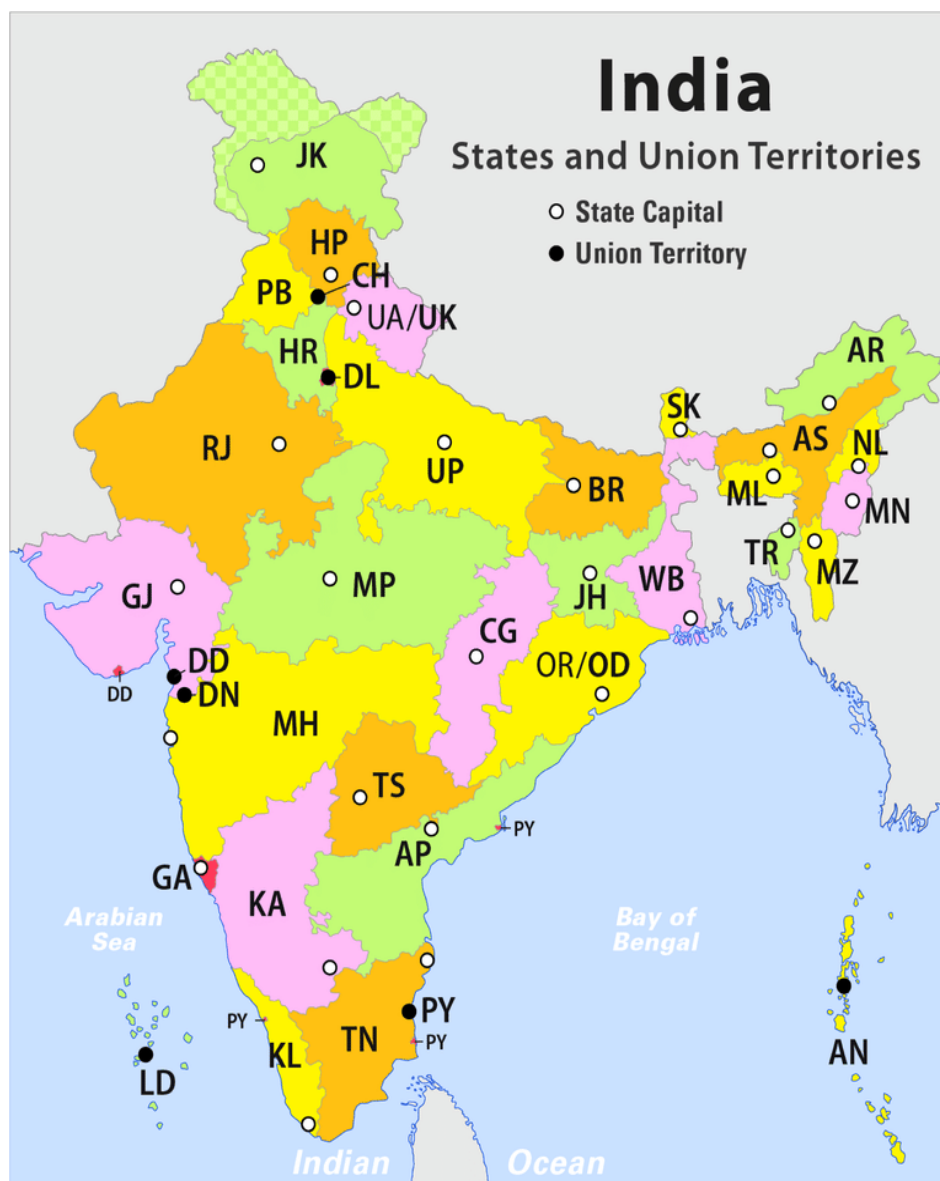

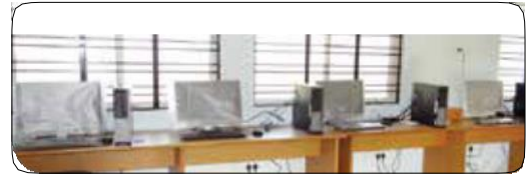

Report of CME

CME for Ayush Teachers on Dravya Guna was organised for 6 days in campus of Sushruta Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital at Satya Hall. The program began with Inaugurals at 9.30 am with the invocation song “Jaya Jananai Sharade” by Miss Samana and team in presence of Dignitaries on and off the stage.

 - Dr Sanghamitra Patnaik did welcome speech followed by lighting lamp from Dignitaries.
 - Dr Sridhara B S (Joint Director, AYUSH, Karnataka) delivered Inaugural address. He focused on Hetu Linga Aushada jnana, importance of Chatushpada, Aushada starts with Dravya Guna, also a scoring subject for students and said to make the subject more clinical oriented. Apart from this also spoke about job avenues for DG Aspirant like clinician, Teacher, placement in Drug Licensing sector/Pharmacy sector, one can involve themselves on cultivation of plants and finally Research and its responsibility of a teacher to mould the students in above said areas. One can take up projects, and insisted to give 20% of medicine from green/ herbal origin in clinical practice, single drug usage like Ashwagandha and Kashta Aushadis too. To add Sahasrayoga, legal aspects like Rule of land, Drug and Cosmetic Act, AFI, API, Bio – Diversity Act in curriculum and nurture students about cultivation, geographic areas like where what to be grown, procurement and preservation of drugs.
 - Dr N K Manjunath Sharma delivered Key Note Address – where he threw light saying medicine has become synonymous with drug. Without drug it is not considered as medicine/treatment. Data generation is the key factor and leads to future wisdom....like allopathy medicine, research should be conducted in Ayurveda also phase wise clinical trial

1,2,3,,etc. The Shastra is rich source of research but we are lacking in converting those information in to process, we opt for symptomatic relief which is not safer on longer run, but Ayurveda treats root cause. There is lot of scope for Dravya Guna subject hence integrative and holistic approach is the need of an hour. People who are Md in DG must be a clinician and researcher, preparing medicine and seeing patient should go hand in hand. Also emphasized the western countries methodology like how people spend time in lab and clinics. One should always try to reverse the condition with drugs and to exchange this knowledge CME is the key. If we are not involving ourselves in research, so called westerners would take away our hidden treasure so we should become role model for the globe.

- Dr H R Nagendra addressed the gathering – he congratulated for bringing right person Dr Sridhara B S (Joint Director, AYUSH, Karnataka) for function. Sir said allopathy science believe in matter, chemicals, organs, tissues, DNA, RNA etc that is matter based approach. Whereas Ayush system focus on consciousness. Maintaining wholesomeness is very much essential. How allopathy drug has become popular because of immediate effect and giving relief to patients in no time and devastated other system, similarly such drugs should be found out and brought into light from Samhita. Also one should have strong hold on Vyakarana, Sanskrit, Tarka because translated books will give ideas of the author he has understood and written in his point of view. So Ayurveda people should also focus on literary research. Depth understanding of Shastra and promotion of positive health should be the goal of Ayurvedic people.
- Dr B R RAMAKRISHNA delivered presidential address. – Adhyayana, Adhyapana, Tadvidya Sambhasha is required for the Ayurveda fraternity and Sambhasha between Bhishak improves the knowledge for which CME is organised. Patients will not approach clinics with traditionally mentioned symptoms, every patient exhibits new symptoms which is totally different from other, Ayurveda is patient centric and all those can be clarified in CME which is a kind of Tadvidya Sambhasha. volunteered and gave feedback on the Life Skill training program and how they utilised the program.

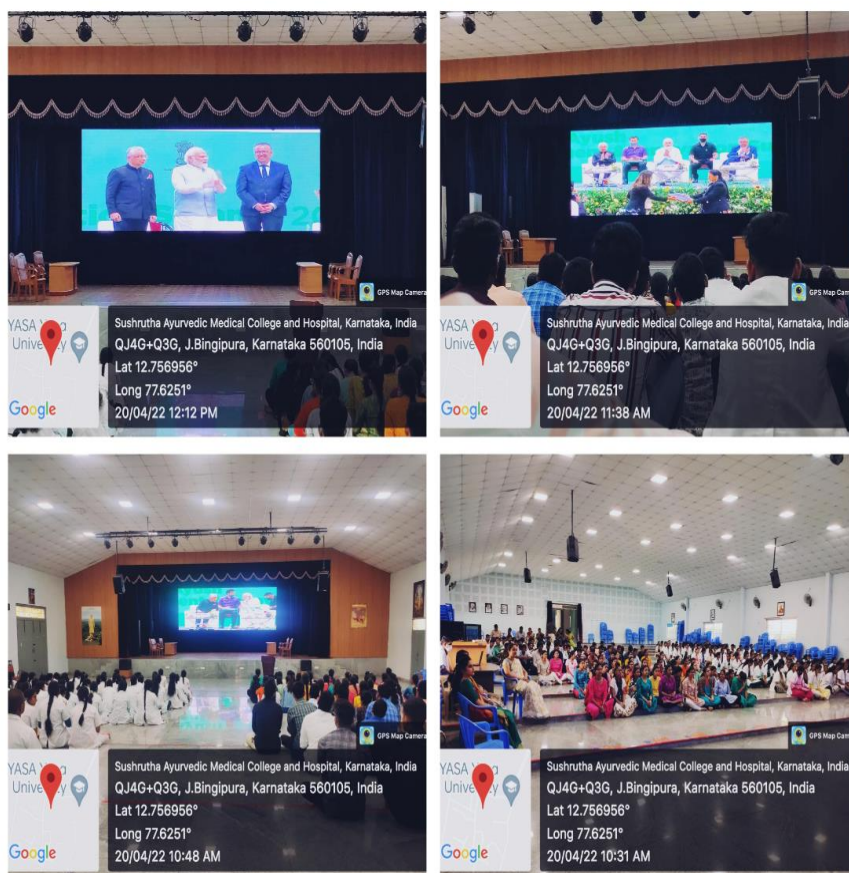

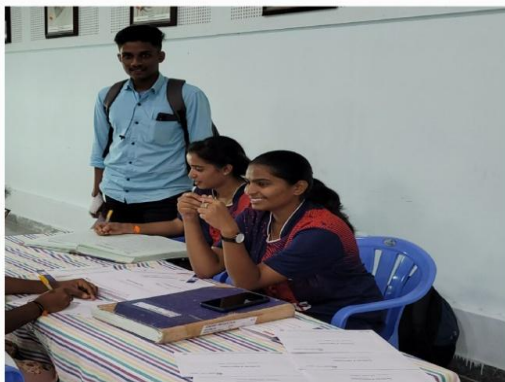
