**Participants:** Staff & Students (Batches - Panthers, Titans, Dakshas) ~150


**Overview:** The Theatre Club of SAMC&H conducted a club activity – ‘Documentary screening on Stage Design’ on 21st February, 2026 at Santosha Hall from 2:00 PM to 3:10 PM. The session was organized with the objective of enhancing students’ understanding of the technical and creative aspects of theatre, particularly focusing on the concept of stage design.

**Description:** The program began with an introduction regarding purpose of the activity by **Dr Nischal, NSS PO, SAMCH** and began with the **screening of a short documentary** from the series ‘**Abstract**’ available on Netflix related to the **concept of stage design**. The documentary provided valuable insights into various elements such as set construction, spatial arrangement, lighting techniques, prop management, backdrop design, and overall visual aesthetics. It emphasized the importance of stage planning in strengthening storytelling, mood creation, and audience engagement. Following the screening, an **interactive discussion** session was conducted. The discussion highlighted how effective stage design can transform even simple performances into impactful presentations.

**Outcome:** The session enhanced students understanding of backstage coordination and the technical planning required for successful theatrical performances. It encouraged creative thinking, teamwork, and appreciation for the multidisciplinary nature of theatre arts. The activity proved to be informative, engaging, and beneficial for all members of the Theatre Club. The students were told to come up with models and concepts related Ayurveda using the same.




### Mental, Emotional, Social wellbeing BEFORE participating in Club activities
