Report on Educational Visit to Sewage Treatment Plant

Official permission for the educational visit was obtained from the Chief Engineer of the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board (BWSSB), Kaveri Bhavan, Bengaluru.

On 29th May 2026, the II Professional BAMS students (Batch 2023–24) visited Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) under BWSSB in two separate batches. The morning session comprised **42 students from A Batch**, while the afternoon session comprised **39 students from B Batch**.

The **A Batch** visited the **V Valley STP Unit**, whereas the **B Batch** visited the **Doddabele STP Unit**. Initially, permission had been sought for both batches to visit the Doddabele STP Unit. However, owing to maintenance work being carried out at the facility, one batch was reassigned to the V Valley STP Unit.

During the visit, the students received a detailed orientation from BWSSB technical personnel regarding the various stages of wastewater treatment. They were introduced to the complete sewage treatment process, including **preliminary, primary, secondary, and tertiary treatment stages**. The staff also demonstrated the advanced technologies used for wastewater purification, treatment, and recycling.

The visit enabled students to gain valuable knowledge about:

- Scientific approaches to sewage management and treatment
- The significance of wastewater treatment in protecting public health and maintaining environmental sustainability
- The role of BWSSB in promoting sustainable urban water management practices

The field visit proved to be highly informative and provided students with an opportunity to connect classroom concepts with practical applications in environmental health and sanitation. **Dr. Athira A. G., Assistant Professor, Department of Swasthavritta Evam Yoga**, accompanied the students throughout the visit, ensuring discipline and compliance with the safety protocols prescribed by BWSSB.
